- 3. Location & Access**  
*Where can I find sources and how do I find information in each source?*
- 4. Use of Information**  
*What information in each source is useful and how should I record my notes?*
- 5. Synthesis**  
*How should I organize the information to meet the requirements of my task?*
- 6. Evaluation**  
*Is my project complete?  
Did I meet each requirement?*
